In modern times, people have communicated by letter, telegraph and telephone. But no one method has become as widespread as quickly as the use of email . The first email message took place in 1971, and according to its sender, Ray Tomlinson, it was probbaly the following : "QWERTYUIOP". What was significant about that ? Nothing , really . This is just the top row of keys on an Englishlanguage keyboard. Tomlinson was just testing out the system and using a nonsesnse message. He had no concept that he was going to start a revolution in communication. Tomlinson was one of a group of scientists who were working on developing better computers. Scientists at his site were able to send a message to a "mailbox" on the computer on their site. Other scientists could view the messages in the mailbox. But there were other computers at other sites where scientists were working on the same project. Tomlinson's idea was to gure out a way to deliver messages to mailboxes on those remote computers. He used the @ sign to identify messages that were headed out of the local machine to the more distant ones. That was the start of the emailing systems that we still use today.

The RMS Titanic was a cruise ship that sank in the North Atlantic Ocean on April 15, 1912. It is one of the deadliest ship disasters in history.

For its first trip, the Titanic was to sail from Southampton. England to New York City, USA. At the time it was the largest ship ever built. The ship even had watertight compartments for safety. Many thought Titanic was unsinkable. The ship left Southampton on April 10, 1912. There were 2,433 people onboard.

On April 14, the Titanic hit an iceberg. Over the next two and a half hours, the ship filled with water and sank. There were not enough lifeboats for everyone. Some people were able to get into lifeboats, but many were not. Those in the water died within minutes because the water temperature was 28 degrees. 
